

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP  
BOARD HELD ON MONDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2004, AT 7:00P.M.**

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present-Bushong, Fackler, Hohman and Blasius.  
Absent-Olson

Bushong made a motion to approve the October minutes and this motion was seconded by Fackler.

Bushong read the October minutes of the Tuscola Township Planning Commission.

Fackler reported that the survey on the Hart property is being completed.

Fackler recommended the following criteria for correcting the well problem: Locate the old well, obtain a new well driller to chlorinate, blow well and re-chlorinate and ask the T.C.H.D. to provide the procedures to narrow down any other possibilities.

The following roads were selected for 2005 year bids: Barkley & Lewis for bit mat, Lorenzo from Frankenmuth to Weaver, Richville from Frankenmuth to Weaver.

The T.C.R.C. resolution of abandonment of Elm St. was signed

Fackler made a motion to approve the bid and survey agreement for drains on both sides of Main St. and this motion was seconded by Hohman. Carried. The amount charged to the township would be \$2,000.00.

Fackler distributed the Michigan Privy Law regulations for review.

Fackler reported that Waste Management has issued new guide lines for the pickup of tires. The new regulations require that all tires are to be cut in two and beverage containers are banned from trash. (non-carbonated beverage containers and green glass are not included.

Fackler made a motion to re-affirm the resolution made on April 23, 2002, concerning the abandonment of the Turnpike to Flint and Turnpike to Lapeer. He also requested the T.C.R.C. to abandon the above-mentioned streets. This motion was seconded by Bushong. Carried.

Blasius made a motion to correct the budget as follows: \$500 from Contingency to Assessor Expenses; \$400 from Contingency to Auditing; \$1200.00 from Contingency to Elections; \$5000.00 from Contingency to Recreation Program; \$500.00 from Contingency to Treasurer Expense; \$500.00 from Contingency to Zoning Board of Appeals. This motion was seconded by Bushong. Carried.

Fackler reported that the M.T.A. attorney has stated that the township does not have to obtain a court order to transfer the abandoned roads to the adjacent property owners.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$20,520.69. It was moved by Blasius and seconded by Bushong to accept these bills for payment. Roll call vote: Yes-Fackler, Hohman, Blasius, Bushong.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
