

**MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY,
AUGUST 16, 2005, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present-Bergdolt, Fackler, Olson and Blasius. Absent-Bishop.

Fackler requested that discussion on purchase of new copier be added to the agenda.

Bergdolt made a motion to accept the July minutes and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Bishop arrived at 7:10 p.m.

Fackler read the minutes of the August 3rd meeting of the Planning Commission.

Fackler reported that the minutes of the VAAS and Bullard Sanford Library are on file.

Fackler made a motion to approve the Tuscola County Economic Development invoice in the amount of \$850.00. This motion was seconded by Bergdolt. Carried. Fackler will check on how this fee is calculated.

Schmandt distributed the new blight list.

Fackler moved the Tuscola Citizens Council item under new business to the next order of business. Doug Wischmeyer and Jan Krumnauer were present to report on the past summer ball season and to request help from the township with the rebuilding on the large ball diamond. After some discussion, they will compile a wish list to submit to the township board by December before the new budget is determined.

Under unfinished business, Fackler reported that the deed is being recorded and will be sent from the Register of Deeds shortly for the property adjacent to the township hall.

Bishop made a motion to send the proposed land division application and current land division ordinance to Lohrstorfer for review. This motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Blasius made a motion to designate the township reviewer of the Land Division Application to be the township assessor with the authority to approve or deny the application. This motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Fackler tabled the Vassar fire contract until the City of Vassar submits requested information to the township board.

Fackler made a motion to change of frontage requirement in the agricultural district from 330' to 200'. This motion was seconded by Blasius. Carried.

Blasius made a motion to pursue the necessary information to eventually provide police protection for the township. This motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried.

Olson reported on the copier estimates and will continue to obtain more models.

Olson will contact Jim Harper from Harper Alarms to submit an estimate for alarm protection at the old township hall.

Fackler will contact Kim Bishop to serve as township representative on the VAAS.

Fackler recommended David Bushong to serve on the Parks and Recreation Board.

Blasius made a motion to approve David Bushong's appointment to the Parks and Recreation Board and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$54,023.31. It was moved by Olson and seconded by Blasius to accept these bills for payment. Roll call vote: yes-Bishop, Bergdolt, Olson, Blasius, and Fackler.

This meeting was adjourned at 9:45 P.M.
