

**MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY,  
JUNE 20, 2006, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present-Bergdolt, Fackler, Bishop, Olson and Blasius.

Fackler ask that the paragraph concerning the speed traffic control order only address the rescind order S79-187-63 which would change the speed from 0.4 of a mile southwest of Frankenmuth Road on VanCleve from 45 mph to 55 mph. Bergdolt made a motion to approve the May minutes with this correction. This motion was seconded by Bishop.

Fackler read a thank you note from the family of Eleanor Trinklein.

Fackler read the minutes of the May 3 and June 1<sup>st</sup> meetings of the Planning Commission.

The minutes of the VAAS and Tuscola County Economic Development are on file for review.

Schmandt distributed the blight list for the township. After some discussion concerning high weeds, Fackler recommended that Schmandt send a notice giving 10 days for owners to mow high weeds and grass and if not mowed send another letter stating that it will be sent to the Township Board.

After discussion concerning the question of whether Police Protection should be placed on the November ballot, Fackler made a motion to put on the November ballot a request for 2 mills for a 5 year period for police protection. This motion was seconded by Bishop. Roll call vote: Bergdolt-No, Fackler-Yes, Bishop-Yes, Olson-Yes and Blasius-Yes. Carried.

Fackler reported that the attorneys are getting proper procedures for the Main Street drainage proposal.

Bishop will draft a letter to the township attorney regarding the Land Division Procedures and questions concerning the same. Fackler reported that he is currently using the new application.

Spicer submitted a scope of work and estimate of cost for the new parking lot. Survey-\$2,000, Design and bidding phase-\$5,500, construction phase-\$2,000 for a total \$9,500.00.

Bergdolt made a motion to approve the rezoning of 9050 Van Cleve Rd. from mixed development to agriculture. This motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried with 4 yeas and 1 nay.

The Proposed Revision of Chapter 6-Off street parking requirements will be added to the bottom of the list of work session items.

Fackler reported that the T.C.R.C. has sent information concerning a product called Capeseal for surfacing roads. This product would cost \$29,000 per mile. Fackler will contact them for townships that have used this in the past.

Fackler stated that the township will need to sign a new copy of the AT&T Metro Act Request as we do not have a signed copy.

Fackler made a motion to approve the request from Rodammer's to withdraw .48 of an acre on Hart Rd. from PA 116. This motion was seconded by Bergdolt. Carried.

The 2005 Annual Financial Report of the T.C.R.C. is on file.

A copy of the monthly report of the Tuscola County Board of Commissioners was distributed to the board members.

Fackler reported that a Moore Drain detour will be directed into our township.

Fackler reported that a joint meeting between the City of Vassar, Vassar Township and Tuscola Township will be held on June 29, 2006, at 7:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at the Vassar City Hall.

Bishop made a motion to turn over the blight of Linda Barnum to the attorneys. This motion was seconded by Fackler. Carried.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$78,465.23. It was moved by Olson and seconded by Blasius to approve these bills for payment. Roll call: Yes-Fackler, Bishop, Bergdolt, Blasius and Olson.

Fackler made a motion to adjust the budget in the following areas: \$200 from Training and Education to Planning Commission Expense. This motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

The township board will hold a work session on July 11, 2006, at 7:00 p.m. to address the sign ordinance, freedom of information form, employee manual and Chapter 6.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:50 P.M.
