

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP  
BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 19, 2006, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present: Bergdolt, Fackler, Olson and Blasius. Bishop arrived just after the roll call.

Bergdolt made a motion to accept the minutes of the November meeting and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried with Bishop abstaining.

Fackler read the minutes of the Planning Commission meeting for December 6, 2006.

The minutes for the VAAS and Tuscola County Economic Development are on file.

Schmandt gave a verbal report and stated that it has been the township's policy not to issue violation letters during the month of December.

Fackler submitted the new parking lot prints from Spicer Group.

Fackler reported that the Parks and Recreation grant application had been denied.

Fackler will inquire if the tube crossing Loren Road can be cleaned out or if it will need to be replaced.

The township has not received the survey information on the township's properties as of yet.

Peterson gave a report of grants that could be available and asked the township to submit a "wish list" to a committee that is prepared to apply for grants county-wide. Peterson needs to have this list by March and Bishop will inquire whether any members of the Parks and Recreation committee would like to attend these meetings.

Fackler made a motion to pay the Road Commission only what was previously agreed upon. This motion was seconded by Bergdolt. Carried.

Bishop made a motion that we void the previous motion and pay the Road Commission this year the amount requested but asked them in the future for specific guidelines so we won't have further overrides. This motion was seconded by Olson. Carried with four yeas and Fackler was opposed.

The next joint municipal meeting will be at the Vassar Township Hall on January 18, 2007.

Fackler reported that the 2007 equalized valuation analysis will be Agriculture 8.6%, Industrial 4.7% and Residential 7.6%.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$44,597.46. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Roll call: Yes-Olson, Blasius, Fackler, Bergdolt and Bishop.

This meeting was adjourned at 9:40 P.M.
