

**MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY,
MAY 15, 2007, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 p.m.

Roll call: Present-Bergdolt, Fackler, Olson and Blasius. Absent-Bishop.
Bishop arrived at 7:05 p.m.

Olson made a motion to approve the minutes of the April meeting and this motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried.

Bishop made a motion to approve the minutes of the joint meeting of the Township Board, the Planning Commission, Zoning Board of Appeals and Parks and Recreation Boards and this motion was seconded by Olson. Fackler noted that the statement made with regard to the budget cuts was as follows: Fackler also stated that due to budget cuts, the Planning Commission and Parks and Recreation Boards will have the choice to meet every other month or meet every month with half of the per diem.

Fackler stated that the Planning Commission will meet the first Wednesday of even numbered months, and the Board of Appeals will meet the third Wednesday of March and September.

Fackler stated that the Tuscola County Economic Development minutes are on file.

Schmandt distributed his monthly blight list.

Blasius made a motion to accept the agreement with ATT and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Fackler will contact Doug Wischmeyer to inquire about any future work that may be planned for the parking lot before the start of ball season. If not, Fackler will contact Dick Worth for help to smooth and pack the lot before the ball season begins.

Bergdolt stated that the Cattle Crossing sign has not been replaced. Fackler will contact the T.C.R.C. concerning this sign.

Tod stated that Rowe Engineering will conduct a free presentation on Smart Growth and the Smart Growth Readiness Assessment Tool at the Mott Community College Regional Technology Center on Wednesday, May 30, 2007, from 7:00 to 9:00 P.M.

Fackler read the minutes of the Planning Commission.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$17,355.61. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Roll call: Yes – Olson, Bergdolt, Bishop, Blasius and Fackler.

Discussion was held on how to improve the procedures that are followed for the policies that are required by law. Blasius will contact the MTA for any information that might be available and any information that could be beneficial from other townships. Any information will be addressed at the next board meeting.

This meeting adjourned at 9:20 P.M.
