

**MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY,
AUGUST 21, 2007, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 p.m.

Roll call: Present-Bergdolt, Fackler, Bishop, Olson and Blasius.

Bergdolt made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 24th meeting and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Fackler read the minutes of the Planning Commission.

Fackler reported that the Board of Appeals will hold a meeting on the 3rd Wednesday of September.

Schmandt distributed the blight list for August. Olson made a motion to turn over the high weed blight located at 4680 Cottrell Rd. to the attorney and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Carried .

Fackler reported that the Tuscola County Road Commission will be receiving bids for the Main St. drain on Thursday, August 23, 2007.

Fackler read correspondence from the Tuscola County Road Commission refusing the request from the township to place a three-way stop at VanCleve and Richville Rd. A copy of this letter will be sent to the Andrews.

Fackler read portions of a blight ordinance obtained from Bridgeport Township which addressed the problem of high weeds. This material that has been collected will be forwarded to the Planning Commission for their consideration.

The Tuscola County EDC has requested an annual allocation of \$950.00. Bergdolt made a motion to pay \$950 to the EDC and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Carried.

Fackler reported that the township has a total of 13 fire runs from the City of Vassar Fire Department. The township has been charged with two runs that were not in the township. This will affect the cost charged to the township so the current bill owed to the city will be held pending correction of our total runs.

Fackler reported a Farmland and Open Space Preservation Education Day to be held on September 6, 2007 at the Tuscola Technology Center located at 1401 Cleaver Road in Caro from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

Fackler stated that a letter from DTE Energy informed the township that crews will be in the community during the next few weeks to replace broken street lights.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$24,326.41. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Bishop. Roll call: Yes-Fackler, Olson, Bishop, Blasius, Bishop.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
