

**MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY,  
SEPTEMBER 16, 2008, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 P.M.

Roll call: Present-Bergdolt, Fackler, Bishop, Olson and Blasius.

Fackler moved the agenda item f. Weinlander-Fitzhugh after the approval of the August minutes. Olson made a motion to approve the agenda with the change and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Carried.

Bergdolt made a motion to approve the minutes of the August meeting and this motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried.

Shannon from Weinlander-Fitzhugh was present to explain the 2008 audit for the Township.

Lee Teschendorf , who is a candidate for Tuscola County Sheriff, gave a brief resume concerning his qualifications for county sheriff.

Fackler read the Planning Commission minutes of August 4, 2008.

Fackler reported that the Tuscola County Economic Development minutes are on file.

Schmandt distributed the September blight list.

Fackler reported that the judge has give Wheeler until April 1, 2009, to complete the project on VanCleve Rd.

Fackler and Begg will conduct a conference call to Spicer to clarify the project in regards to the scope of work and the fee proposal for the zoning ordinances.

Blasius made a motion to accept the proposal from Worth Construction in the amount of \$1370.00 for improvements to the township property on VanCleve. (See attached proposal). This motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Fackler updated the board on the Richville Fire Association discussions.

The Tuscola County Board of Commissioners August activity report was distributed.

Fackler reported that the closing of the property on Church Street should happen very soon.

Advance Surveying will be completing the work on VanCleve before winter.

Fackler reported that the MTA county meeting will be September 18, 2008, at 7:00 p.m. at the Juniata Township Hall.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$27,189.74. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Roll call: Yes-Olson, Fackler, Bergdolt, Blasius and Bishop.
