

**MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER
21, 2010, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 p.m.

Roll call: Present-Bushong, Fackler, Bishop, Olson and Blasius.

Bushong made a motion to approve the agenda and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Olson made a motion to approve the minutes of the November meeting and this motion was seconded by Bushong. Carried.

David Erbisch inquired if something could be done to prevent ice from sliding off the roof unto the front sidewalk. After some discussion, Blasius will contact KSC Construction for a possible solution for this potential problem.

Bishop reported that the Planning Commission met the 2nd Wednesday of December and they are proceeding well with the Zoning Ordinances.

Bushong reported that the Parks and Recreation Board met on December 6th and during the meeting in January will be preparing their 2010-2011 budget.

Fackler stated that the minutes of the VAAS are on file for review.

Schmandt distributed the blight report for December 2010. No letters were sent out this month due to the Christmas holidays.

Fackler reported that the Cass River Greenway Water Trail Development meeting for December had been postponed until the first week in January.

The Township has not received any opinion concerning the Anti-Sexual Harassment policy to date.

There has been nothing received concerning the 2011 road projects.

The county will be notified that the township has decided to acquire BS&A software for the Treasurer and Assessor.

Frankenmuth city clerk, Phil Kerns, contacted the township concerning the possible installation of a dry hydrant at either Larry Bauer's pond on Frankenmuth Road or the Timber's pond on Bray Road in the event that fire trucks may have to haul water to a fire.

The township's portion would be \$3500. Fackler made a motion to include this in the upcoming 2011-2012 budget and this motion was seconded by Bushong. Carried.

Fackler reported that he had drawn a water sample on Saturday and should be receiving the results soon.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$11,255.91. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Roll call: yes-Olson, Fackler, Bushong, Bishop and Blasius.

Ed Bergman asked about the status of the Richville Fire Department and whether the township had any ownership in it. He was advised that the township only contracts with Richville Fire Department and has one member on their board.

This meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
