

APPROVED MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP
BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2012, AT 7:00 P.M.

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:00 p.m.

Roll call: Present-Bushong, Fackler, Olson and Blasius. Absent-Bishop

Fackler amended the agenda by removing item h. under unfinished business.

Bushong made a motion to approve the agenda as amended and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Bishop arrived at 7:05 p.m.

David Erbisch stated that the tire pick-up was successful and approximately 200 tires were collected. He suggested that next year the amount of tires from each person be noted in the publication as he had a resident with 80 tires. The amount for each resident is 7 tires.

Bushong made a motion to approve the minutes of the September meeting as printed and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried with Fackler abstaining.

Bishop reported that the Planning Commission has completed their work on the Zoning Ordinances and are awaiting input from Spicer, Group.

Bushong reported that Parks and Recreation Board will meet on November 19, 2012. The electrical on the pavilion is nearly complete and Bushong stated that the nature trail behind the township hall has been flagged and he would like input before the next meeting.

Fackler stated that the minutes of the VAAS for the meeting of August 16th are on file for review.

Schmandt distributed the Zoning Administrator's 3rd Quarterly Report. There have been two new homes built in 2012. He also distributed the blight list for October.

Fackler reported that two checks need to clear with regard to the Cass River Greenway Project before the DNR will release the final grant monies. The DNR will be inspecting the final project in the near future.

Fackler reported that Lohrstorfer will contact the state with regard to the moratorium imposed concerning the township and Construction Code Group of Frankenmuth.

Fackler stated that the final report from AKT Peerless Environmental has been received.

Fackler reported that the T.C.R.C. has agreed to change all yield signs to stop signs within the township as time and materials are available at no cost to the township.

Bushong made a motion to accept the Option 2 proposal from Republic for a five year contract for waste pick-up and this motion was seconded by Bishop. Carried.

Fackler will inquire about the stripping of the parking lot to be completed in May 2013.

Blasius made a motion to accept a one year renewal from Lakeshore Energy and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Blasius made a motion to obtain bids for proposed 2013 road work on the following roads:

Truax Rd.- Richville to Frankenmuth, Loren Rd.-Bray east, Loren Rd.-Buell west, and Waterman Rd.-Hart to Richville. This motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

The Tru-Green proposal was directed to the Parks and Recreation Board.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$29,769.49. Olson made a motion to accept these bills for payment and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Roll call: yes-Bishop, Bushong, Fackler, Blasius and Olson.

This meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
