

**APPROVED MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY,
APRIL 16, 2013, AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 7:10 p.m.

Roll call: Present-Hicks, Fackler, Verbeek, Olson and Blasius.

Fackler added Supervisor's Computer under New Business, Item I to the agenda.

Verbeek made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Olson made a motion to approve the minutes of the March meeting and this motion was seconded by Hicks. Carried.

Verbeek reported that the Parks and Recreation Grant Application was submitted before April 1, 2013. Verbeek also reported that Jaruzel Logging has cleared the walking trail as a service to the township. Two grills have been purchased to be placed beside the pavilion. The next Parks and Recreation meeting will be on Monday, May 13th.

Fackler stated that the minutes of VAAS are on file for review.

Fackler reported that two zoning permits were issued in the past month.

Craig Kirkpatrick reported on the Cass River Greenway.

Blasius attended the Construction Code Group in Frankenmuth. They agreed that the January 1, 2014, date of implementation would be suitable.

Fackler stated that Ryan from AKT Peerless Environmental will attend the Tuscola Township meeting in May.

Olson made a motion to approve the Frankenmuth Fire Agreement and this motion was seconded by Blasius. Carried.

Verbeek made a motion to re-appoint Larry Kern and Earl Begg to three year terms on the Planning Commission and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried. Blasius made a motion to appoint John Bishop to fulfill Jon Blasius' term on the Planning Commission and this motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Blasius made a motion to give Fackler and Begg the option to either conduct interviews or base their recommendation on the resumes to fill the position of Zoning Administrator.

Fackler reported that the Sexton had some issues with his position and discussion followed.

Fackler will attend the Richville Fire Department meeting on April 18, 2013.

The following bids were received from the T.C.R.C. as follows: Loren Rd. from Bray Rd. East in the amount of \$105,372.05. Loren Rd. from Buell Rd. West in the amount of \$64,979.75, Truax Rd. from Richville Rd. to Frankenmuth Rd. in the amount of \$68, 520.00 and Waterman Rd. from Hart Rd. to Richville Rd. in the amount of \$44,619.00. After much discussion, Olson made a motion to accept the bid for Loren Rd. in its entirety for a total of \$170,351.80. This motion was seconded by Verbeek. Carried.

There was much discussion concerning the possibility of placing a street light or signal light at the Bray and Ormes Rd. intersection. Costs for both lights will be obtained and a decision made following this information.

Fackler reported on an e-mail directed to DTE from Mike Hoagland requesting DTE to pay at the full rate for fire service as is required of other utilities.

Blasius made a motion to approve the resolution for a partial termination of a PA 116 for Anne Enser for property located on Simpson Rd. This motion was seconded by Olson. Carried.

Fackler reported that his computer has been malfunctioning. Olson will contact Justin to uninstall and reinstall Windows 7 to correct this problem.

Verbeek reported the need to have maintenance done on the two outside bathroom doors of the township building. Blasius will contact Hoover and Hornung to provide bids for two new doors.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$12,635.80. It was moved by Olson and seconded by Hicks to accept these bills for payment. Roll call: Yes-Fackler, Blasius, Olson, Verbeek and Hicks.

This meeting was adjourned at 9:40 p.m.
