

**APPROVED MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD ON
MAY 19, 2015, AT 1:00 P.M.**

The meeting was brought to order by the Supervisor, Tod Fackler, at 1:00 p.m.

Trustees present: Fackler, Olson, Hicks, Blasius, and Verbeek.

Hicks made a motion to approve agenda with addition of PA116 added to new business. Seconded by Verbeek. Carried.

Olson made a motion to approve minutes from April meeting. Seconded by Hicks. Carried.

Andrew Masty made a complaint about the condition of Truax Rd. Fackler stated that the board is looking into the possibility of reinforcing the road in the area Masty mentioned, and then resurfacing a portion of the road next year.

Hicks reported that the survey sent out by the Planning Commission went really well and had good feedback. Approx. 140 surveys were returned.

Verbeek reported a picnic table was delivered by the canoe launch. Board discussed putting a trash down at the canoe launch. Verbeek will look into that. Next meeting will be July 30, 2015.

VAAS next meeting will be held on May 21, 2015.

Zoning administrator reported there were no permits issued this past month.

Fackler reported attorney will continue working on burned out house on Sohn Rd. Attorney reviewed the lawn care ordinance proposed

by the Township Board and will have something for us next month. The attorney will have the reimbursement policy ready for review next month.

Hicks will contact attorney Kevin Kilby to get information on the new FOIA laws.

Fackler made a motion to accept Grounds Keeper Contract for \$12,000. Olson seconded. Carried.

Fackler made a motion to approve May 12, 2015 Special Meeting minutes. Olson seconded. Carried.

Fackler received disc of zoning ordinances from Spicer. Hicks will contact Rob Eggers to have them posted to our web-site.

Verbeek made a motion to accept bid from Tom's Seal Coating to fill in the cracks on the parking lot for \$1095. Olson seconded. Carried

Blasius made a motion to put a sign on the township hall door with the hours of operation as 9 a.m. till 12:00 noon on Wednesdays. Seconded by Verbeek. Carried.

Blasius submitted her resignation letter. Olson made a motion to accept her resignation. Fackler seconded. Carried.

Fackler made a motion to fill Clerk's position with deputy clerk, Michelle Hicks, for the remainder of the term. Verbeek seconded. Carried.

After applications were reviewed, Hicks made a motion to accept Sarah Barber's application for open Trustee position. Seconded by Blasius. Carried.

Fackler made a motion to approve PA116's for residents Kern and Keinath. Verbeek seconded. Carried.

Olson made a motion to pay the bills in the amount of \$23,123.81. Hicks seconded. Carried.
