Meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m.

Trustees present: Olson, Verbeek, Hicks, Fackler, and Barber.

Olson made a motion to approve the agenda. Verbeek seconded. Carried.

Olson made a motion to approve the minutes from the October meeting. Verbeek seconded. Carried.

Verbeek reported that they are working on acquiring a grant to purchase more playground equipment that would be designed for 2-5 year olds.

The Bureau of Construction has received our application to Administer and Enforce. The application will be presented to the Construction Code Commission at their January 11, 2017, meeting for review and decision.

Zoning Administrator's report: The burned out house on Sohn Rd. has been removed. Two building permits have been issued this month. There were two blight letters sent out.

Olson made a motion to remove Shirley Olson, Treasurer, and Marsha Wooleber, Deputy Treasurer, from Tuscola Township bank records and add Robert Verbeek, Treasurer, and Wendy Verbeek, Deputy Treasurer, to Tuscola Township bank records effective November 21, 2016. Barber seconded. Carried.

Hicks made a motion to rescind the motion made at the September 20, 2016, board meeting in regards to new times and days of office hours for the Township. Olson seconded. Carried.

Verbeek made a motion to approve two people to attend MTA training in Frankenmuth on December 14, 2016, for new township officials. Fackler seconded. Carried.

Hicks made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 2, 2016, Public Accuracy Test. Olson seconded. Carried.
