

APPROVED MINUTES OF THE APRIL 18, 2017 TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD
MEETING HELD ON APRIL 18, 2017, AT 1:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m.

Trustees present: Hicks, Fackler, Barber, Verbeek, Rodammer.

Fackler made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition of Gary Hicks under 'Guest', the Township application under 'New Business E', and the proposed zoning ordinance changes under 'New Business F'. Verbeek Seconded. Carried.

Fackler made a motion to approve the minutes from the Public Budget meeting on March 21, 2017. Rodammer seconded. Carried.

Fackler made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting on March 21, 2017. Rodammer seconded. Carried.

Fackler made a motion to approve the minutes from the special meeting on March 31, 2017. Barber seconded. Carried.

Fackler made a motion to approve the minutes from the work session on March 31, 2017. Rodammer seconded. Carried.

Gary Hicks from Republic Waste Services was present to discuss the renewal of the solid waste contract.

Rodammer made a motion to accept Option #1 offered by Republic Waste which will add every other week recycling with a cart instead of a bin @ \$13.94/ month per household. This is a five year contract. Carts will be delivered over the summer months along with a calendar showing when pickup dates will be. Verbeek seconded. Carried. Hicks abstained.

There will be a community build at the Township hall on April 29th, 2017, at 9:00 a.m., to finish the playground.

Zoning Board of Appeals will meet Wednesday, the 19th, at 7:00 p.m.

Parks and Rec's next meeting will be Thursday, the 20th, at 7:00 p.m.

Fackler attended the meeting at the state for the Construction Code Group. They have put us on the agenda for their July meeting.

Fackler is filling in for the zoning administrator's position. There were two permits issued and two pending for this month. The Board gave Fackler permission to speak with the attorney on being more aggressive with blight issues.

Bill Zehnder's annual paddle and swim on the Cass River is June 24th. August 5th is the triathlon. June 10th is the annual Cass River clean up in Cass City this year.

Land acquisition is waiting on a closing date. There were a couple issues with the title company that have been resolved now but that had held things up.

Rodammer excused himself from the meeting at 2:30 p.m.

Fackler received the bill for half of the total cost of the roads, \$78,282.87.

Barber made a motion to adopt the new application for Township appointment with changes. Verbeek seconded. Carried.

Yard waste is May 18th.

Hicks will post in paper that we have positions available. June 1st will be the deadline for applications.

Verbeek made a motion to pay the bills in the amount of \$11,463.61. Hicks seconded. Carried.
