

APPROVED MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING HELD ON JULY 21ST, 2020 AT 1:00 P.M.

Hicks made a motion to approve the agenda. Barber seconded. Carried.

Barber made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 16th meeting. Verbeek seconded. Carried.

Fackler made a motion to approve minutes from the July 8th Election Commission meeting. Hicks seconded. Carried.

Seven residents of the village were present to discuss their concerns with the blight issues in the Township. This will be addressed in the upcoming weeks by our blight officer, Gary Hicks. Tuscola Township recently adopted new blight ordinances that went into effect July 4th, 2020. These ordinances can be found on our website at tuscolatownship.org.

Steve Shriner made a complaint about the mowing at the cemetery. No board action was taken.

Barber made a motion to approve the Letter of Authorization giving Spicer permission to submit permit applications on the Township's behalf when working on the project of the erosion at the cemetery. Verbeek seconded. Carried.

Hicks made a motion to allow Douglas Bergman to build bat houses and blue bird houses on Tuscola Township property as part of his requirements for the Boy Scouts. Parks and Rec will fund the project and determine how many houses, where they will be placed, and how tall they will be. Barber seconded. Carried.

Hicks made a motion to approve the PA 116 for Chester and Shirley Petzold. Verbeek seconded. Carried.

Fackler made a motion to approve Resolution # 2020-9 that allows the removal of 2.51 acres from PA 116 for John and Stephanie Sahr. Rodammer seconded. Carried.

Verbeek made a motion to pay the bills in the amount of \$21,830.81. Rodammer seconded. Roll call: Yes- Hicks, Barber, Fackler, Rodammer, Verbeek. No- 0. Carried.
