

APPROVED MINUTES OF THE TUSCOLA TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
MEETING HELD ON NOVEMBER 16TH, 2021 AT 1:00 P.M.

Trustees present: Rodammer, Verbeek, Barber, Fackler, Hicks

Guests: 2

Hicks made a motion to approve the agenda. Verbeek seconded. Carried.

Rodammer made a motion to approve the minutes from the October meeting. Barber seconded. Carried.

Jeremy McCallister, from Heritage Monuments gave a presentation on columbariums.

Hicks made a motion to give Hicks and Fackler permission to decide what graves need to be relocated at the Tuscola Township Cemetery with the goal being to relocate graves that are at risk of being lost in the Cass River in the event of another bank failure. Barber seconded. Carried.

Planning Commission submitted their meeting dates for the year of 2022.

Rodammer made a motion to raise the special assessment for garbage to \$192.15/household due to a fuel surcharge and the Genesee Solid Waste charge on the garbage bill. Hicks seconded. Carried.

Hicks made a motion to have DTE replace 28 street lights with LED bulbs with an upfront cost of \$10,897. After a 3.31 years payback there will be a savings of \$3181.92/yr. Rodammer seconded. Carried.

Barber made a motion to change the fee for the pavilion rental to \$40 with no deposit. Verbeek seconded. Carried.

Verbeek made a motion to pay the bills in the amount of \$26,345.91. Hicks seconded. Roll call: Yes- Fackler, Rodammer, Barber, Hicks, Verbeek. No- 0. Carried.

Board of Trustees went to Tuscola Township Cemetery to discuss potential future site of a columbarium.
