

Tuscola Township Planning Commission
Minutes August 6, 2014 approved

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 P.M. by acting Chairperson, John Bishop. All Commissioners were present.

Minutes were read, corrected and approved as corrected. Michelle Hicks read the Township Board Minutes. John Bishop announced that the Planning Commission will now be meeting monthly to review and update the land use plan.

Mike Damm was present from Blasius requesting to change the property where Dykhouse Pickle Company was located to Industrial from the current zoning of agricultural, as they would like to purchase the property and move the current plant operation from the village of Tuscola to the Ormes Rd. location.

A resolution was made by Craig Kirkpatrick to consider holding a public hearing to see what the landowners feel about rezoning the Agricultural property currently owned by Leon and Arlene Dykehouse 167 acres located on Ormes Rd. back to industrial. This was supported by John Bishop and the vote was unanimous. A Public hearing will be set up for September 3rd at 7:00P.M. at the Township Hall.
